

# WHAT TO DO IF MAINTENANCE TIMERS DON'T SHOW UP ON EDGE

## WHEN TO FOLLOW THIS PROCEDURE


If you go to the Maintenance screen and all the timers are mysteriously missing:



## WHAT TO DO

For this procedure, you will need your printer connected to your local network, and a computer with a web browser.

1. Go to *[your printer's IP address]/plugins/*. You will likely see the second plugin, called *Maintenance Timers*, that is not running.




2. Click "Start". Wait 10 seconds. If the plugin does not turn itself back off, you're done. Go to the *Maintenance* screen to confirm the timers now show up.

## If the plugin turns itself back off:

**NOTE:** This procedure will overwrite any timer data on the machine (total print time, etc).

1. [Download this file here.](#)
2. Go to *[your printer's IP address]/files/system/*
3. Click on "Upload system files" and upload the file you downloaded. It will replace the corrupted copy on your printer.



4. Go back to *[your printer's IP address]/plugins/* and try to restart the plugin again. It should now stay on.
5. Go to the Maintenance page and confirm the timers now show up.
